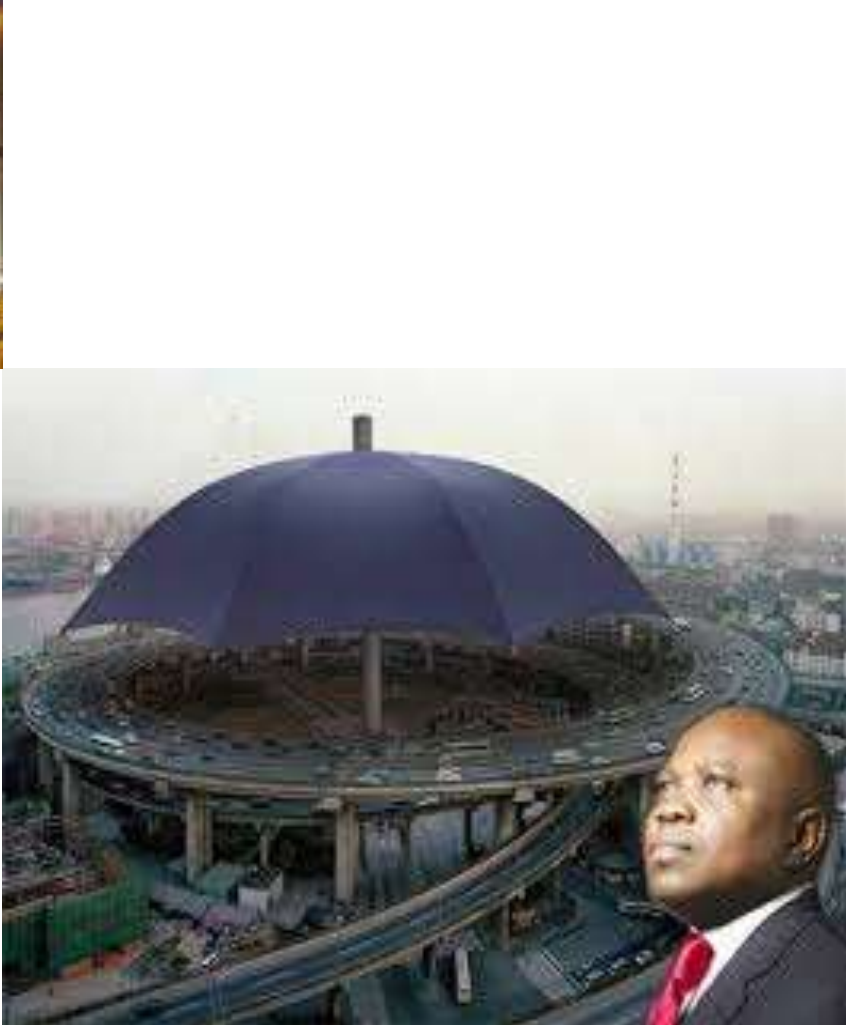
Work-related deaths have increased from 2.3M to 2.78M per Annum

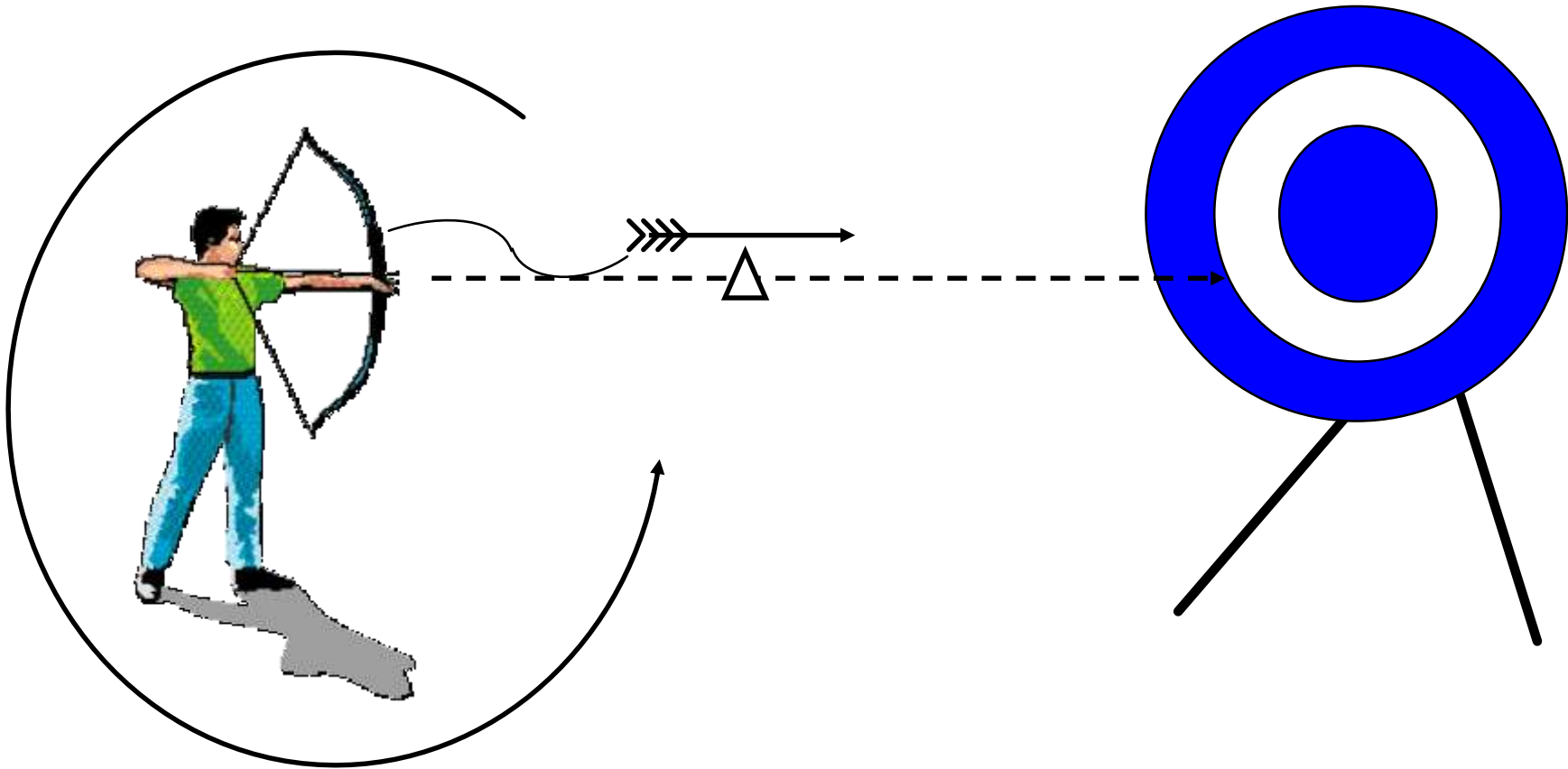

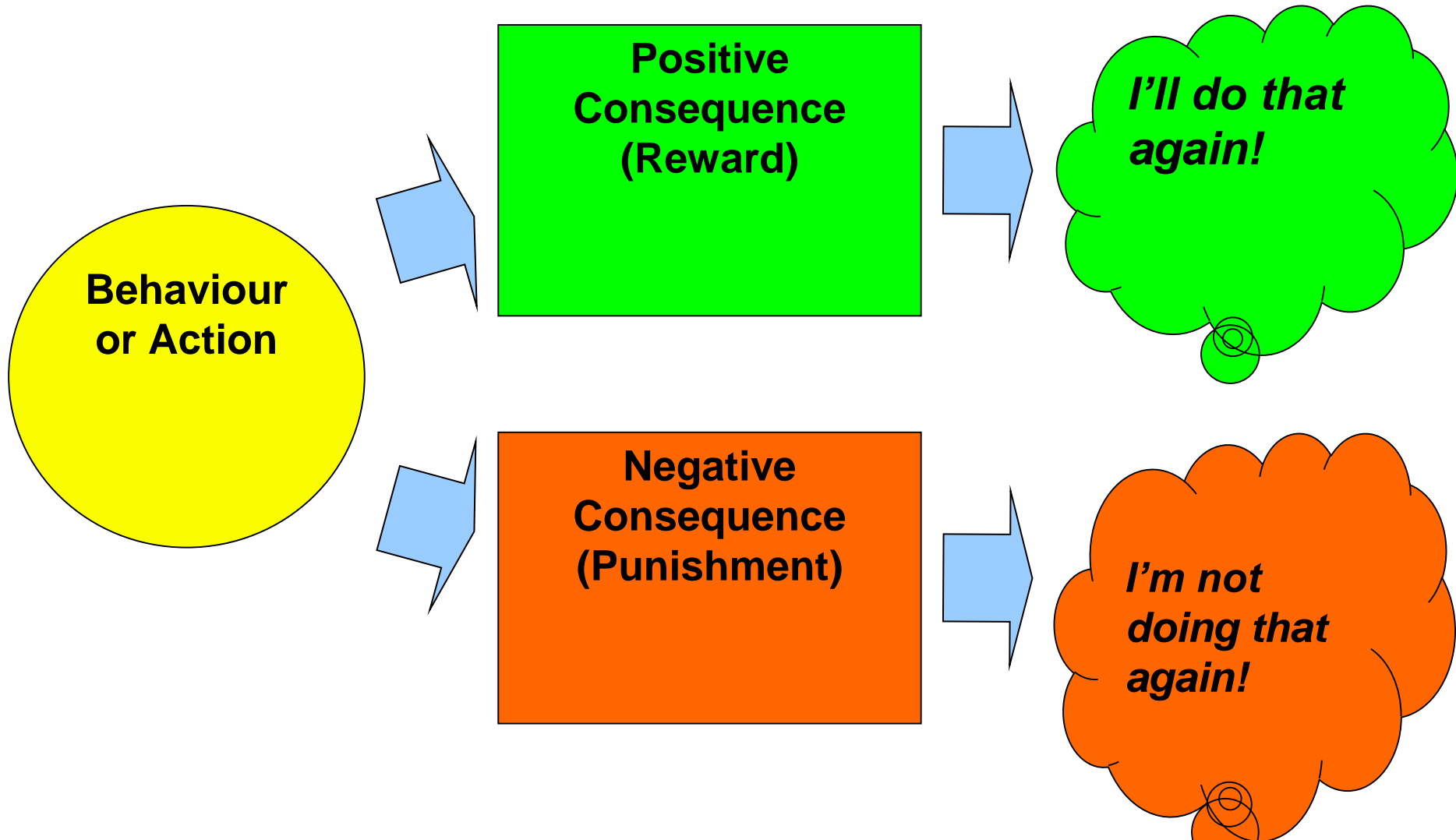
